You will find overleaf an application form for membership of the 'Swadlincote Rifle & Pistol Club'.

If your application is accepted it will be necessary for you to serve a minimum three months probationary membership period.

There are two classes of probationary member the first one being 'Blue Badge' which will be applied :-

- 1) *If you are already a full member of another club which has been approved by the Secretary of State in respect of the same type or types of firearm and will provide you with a reference; or*
- 2) *If you hold a current firearms certificate but are not a member of another club; or*
- 3) *If you have handled firearms in the course of your duty in the police or the armed services, and have a statement from your existing or former senior/commanding officer saying that you are fully trained in handling the type of firearms in respect of which the club has obtained 'Home Office' approval and are able to use them safely without supervision.*

The second class of probationary member is 'Green Badge' which will be applied :-

- *To all other applicants who wish to shoot firearms*

The full probationary NRA based training course will apply to all 'Green Badge' probationary members and to category (2) above 'Blue Badge' probationary members, who are 17 years of age and over.

Green badge probationary or junior firearms members must be supervised at all times, on a one to one basis, when in possession of firearms or ammunition, by either the range officer or a full 'Red Badge' member of the club, or someone who is a coach with a qualification recognised by the Great Britain Target Shooting Federation and/ or governing bodies.

The current club fees, as decided at the 2009 AGM, are as follows :-

a) Standard membership one year subscription	£134
b) Senior (age 65 years or over)	£67
c) Spouse (the partner of an applicant or current member)	£67
d) Young Person (age 17 but under 21)	£67
e) Junior (up to 17 years of age)	£33.50
